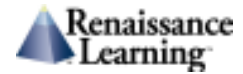


## R43100—NEO and Dana Printer Compatibility List

If you are connecting a NEO™ or Dana directly to a printer with a USB cable, the following guidelines can be used to determine if a printer will be compatible.

1. A printer will NOT be compatible with the NEO or Dana if the specifications indicate “Hostbased”, “Host-1. driven” printing, or GDI emulation. These printers do not have a driver built into the printer and are completely controlled by the computer. Our devices require a driver on the printer to process the data.
2. The printer is likely to be compatible if the model supports PCL 1 – 6 drivers (HP, Brother, Lexmark and other brand printers).
3. The printer is likely to be compatible if the model supports ESC emulation (Epson brand printers).

NOTE: Due to the short life cycle of printers, Renaissance Learning™ does not test specific models for compatibility.
