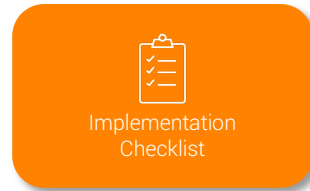




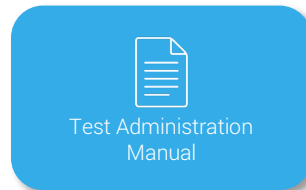
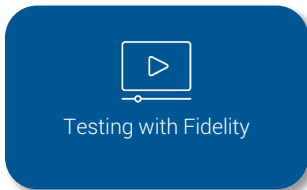
Smart Start: Use Precise Data to Focus Instruction
