Understanding the Star Unified Scale

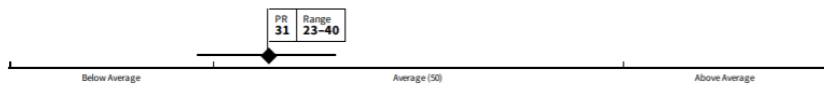
Your child has recently taken a Renaissance Star assessment. Your child's teacher uses the results to measure general achievement in reading and/or math, and to determine your child's learning needs.

Recently, Renaissance transitioned to the Star Unified Scaled Score. Please note that only the scale is changing – all other scores will remain the same. The visual below may be helpful in understanding the change. You may also want to think about this using the analogy of Fahrenheit vs. Celsius (32 degrees in Fahrenheit and 0 degrees in Celsius both mean freezing, they're just on different scales).

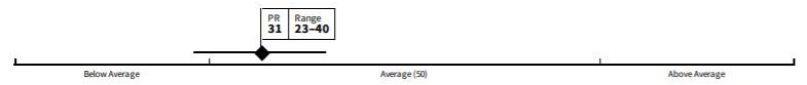
